Finding Routing Numbers for Intermediary Banks

** If you have the SWIFT code for a bank please follow these steps to locate the routing number needed to complete your international wire properly.**

Any bank information shown in this guide is to be used as an example, not necessarily accurate information for your wire payee.

- 1. Visit <u>UID Lookup | The Clearing House</u>
- 2. Type supplied BIC/SWIFT into search bar and click 'GO!'

Search by BIC/SWIFT						
Enter the entire BIC/SWIFT code or just the beginning letters to see a list of UIDs beginning with the entered letters.

- 3. Click on the UID Number to show list of available participants. You will want to note the participant number that corresponds with the bank name you select.
 - An example of the list that pops up:

- 4. In a separate window go to the follow website: <u>FRFS: Search for Fedwire Participants</u> (<u>frbservices.org</u>)
- 5. Read the Federal Reserve Banks' terms of use for the E-Payments Routing Directory and if you agree with the statement select 'Agree' to move forward with this process



6. Fill in Bank name that you selected from step 3 and click 'search'

- 7. Look for the routing number that includes the participant number from UID look up website.
 - Using this example, The Bank of New York Mellon is participant# 0001 (found in image from step 3a) and the routing number for row 2 from the Fedwire website includes 0001
